BRIEFING INFORMATION ON 5 NEW GARBAGE TRUCKS

All of the garbage trucks were tendered in accordance with the Central Tender Committee (CTC) guidelines and procured by the Department of Vehicle and Equipment services (DVES) on behalf of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Health and Culture for the Department of Environmental Health.

These trucks are in addition to the new Al Jon Waste Compactor unit which is now operational at the George Town landfill. The 10 new trucks will consist of 3 residential rear loader trucks (2 here now and 1 left to be ship next week); 3 Front Loader Trucks (all 3 here) for commercial waste; 3 Roll On / Roll Off Trucks (due to ship by end of March) for commercial waste; and 1 Grapple Truck (due to arrive in two weeks) for residential and commercial waste. Funding for the ten (10) new garbage trucks came from last year's, 2014-15 budget.

We have received 5 of the 10 new garbage trucks that have been procured as outlined below:
